Training Session 5

The Foundation: Practicing Prayer

Objective

Help you hear God speak to you through His word and learn to pray

Key Text

Matthew 6:9-13

Bible Study

We're spending another week on prayer because prayer requires practice. Like most things in life, there is simply no other way to develop skill in prayer other than practice, so continue reading the suggested daily Bible reading and continue practicing the model for prayer that we learned last week. You may choose to pray through The Lord's Prayer using the model we learned (A.C.T.S.) or you may use each of the seven petitions in the Lord's prayer as another way to pray, which is the key text mentioned above (Matthew 6:9-13). You can never go wrong praying the way Jesus taught his disciples to pray!

This week, we're going to learn another model of prayer that helped save me during a particularly dark season of my life. As life began rushing out of control, I searched the Scriptures, clinging to each promise like a puppy in a raging river. The result is this prayer. These promises of God were a lifeline to me then, and they still are now! They will hold. Each one is directly from the Bible. You can count on them because God always makes good on his promises!

Personally, I pray this most every day, typically as a voice recording on my drive to work. Each promise will remind you of who you are as a son or daughter of the Most High King and also who you are called to be as a result of your identity as a beloved son or daughter of God. The refrain emphasizes God's call for us to live differently, to live by faith and through the power of the Holy Spirit. The repetition--by faith and through the power of the Spirit--is designed to help

us clear the hurdle we repeatedly stumble over in life, living by sight and through the power of self-effort.

Below, you will find two versions--one for men and the other for women. The written version will allow you to see the Biblical references. You may choose, like I did, to record a voice memo on your phone of yourself reading the prayer and listen to it on the way to work (or anytime). Alternatively, we have recorded a version for women and a version for men. Those voice recordings are hyperlinked here...

Praying the Promises of God for Women

- Today, by faith & through the power of your Spirit, I will step into the work that you have called me to do, knowing that you have called me to this work and that you will use it for your glory and the renewal of all things (Eph. 2:8-10; Rev. 21:5).
- Today, by faith & through the power of the Spirit, I will love my neighbors and serve my church and city (Mark 12:31; Jer. 29:7; Eph. 4:11-13).
